Welcome back to a new school term! We hope you all had a lovely Easter break. This promises to be an exciting and productive term, full of fun and engaging learning opportunities.

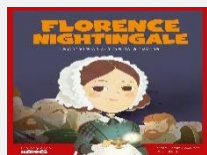

Our overarching theme for the summer term is Civilisations, which will run through all subject areas.

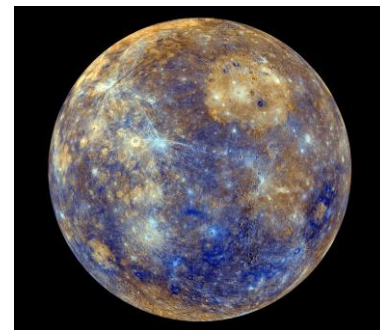
