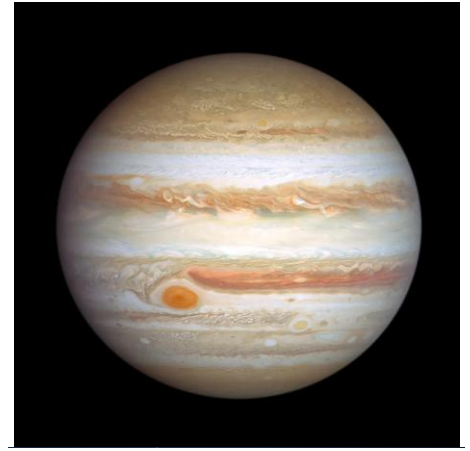


Jupiter Class



Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back! We hope you had a fantastic summer and enjoyed some special time together. We are excited to begin a new term in Jupiter Class, with lots of engaging learning, exciting experiences and opportunities for the children to challenge themselves and develop their skills.

Math's

This term, Jupiter Class will be developing their understanding of place value, exploring numbers up to and across 1,000. The children will learn how numbers are made up of thousands, hundreds, tens and ones, and will use this knowledge to read, write, compare and represent numbers. They will then build on their place value skills as they begin to explore addition and subtraction across 1,000. The children will develop their understanding of different methods for solving calculations and will be encouraged to explain their thinking and use their mathematical knowledge to solve problems.

English

We will begin by exploring *Interview with a Tiger* by A. Seed, using it as inspiration to write our own animal interviews. We will then explore *Lord of the Forest* by Caroline Pitcher and write our own stories, focusing on adjectives and expanded noun phrases to make our writing more descriptive. Alongside this, we will work hard to improve handwriting, presentation and punctuation, encouraging the children to take pride in their work and become confident writers.

This term in history, our students are embarking on an exciting journey to answer the big question "Why do we remember the Second World War?" Please talk to your children about world events from 1939-1945.

This term in science, our young scientists are deepening their understanding of humans and animals by answering the big question: What if your skeleton was made of a flexible material? You can support your child's learning by discussing different animals and their skeleton at home.

In our art lessons we will be looking at how colour can create mood and meaning in artwork. We have already started to work with watercolour which has been really exciting.
