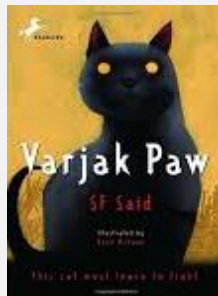
In our Mathematics, Mars class shall mainly be focusing on fractions; including recognizing equivalent fractions, simplifying fractions and adding and subtracting fractions.
