Welcome Back

Unfortunately, recruitment of Teaching Assistants is an issue nationally, and we are not the only schools experiencing this challenge.

Hopefully you have now received your class newsletter outlining what the focus is in each class. You should also soon be receiving the programme of Enrichment Clubs for each school. As you know, the Government funding for supporting the free enrichment hour has come to an end. We are trying to put on a full club offer as well as we can but we are required to make it financially viable and are also limited with staffing. We realise that there are some gaps and we very much hope that as the term progresses we can fill these and extend the provision we are able to offer.

Attendance:

This academic year the government is really focused on improving attendance within schools, and will be monitoring this closely. They are keen to discourage unauthorised absence, and as a Trust we are in agreement with this. We fully appreciate that many holidays were disrupted due to COVID and families are rebooking ones that were previously cancelled. However, this leads to children missing vital elements of schooling on top of the already large impact of COVID disruption and absence. Our staff are committed to addressing areas of learning that have been impacted, and further absence makes this even harder for your child. Our Trust has historically not issued penalty fines on behalf of the local authority and any decisions to fine have been at the discretion of the School leaders. However, the Trust stance on this is changing and fines may well be carried out (and these apply to each child in your family). Therefore, I am asking that you think carefully before booking holidays during term time.

Diary dates:

We have begun to plan in some of the key dates for this term and these can be found on the next page. We will be adding to these very soon, with the Christmas events in the diary. This will be included in every newsletter so please keeping checking it for updates. We want to give you as much notice as possible about events as we know you are busy people, and sometimes need to make changes to work commitments.

Celebration Assemblies:

We really enjoy celebrating the success of your children, and we want you to share that with you. Therefore we will be starting our Celebration assemblies next week - will continue on a 3-week cycle and again, the dates are on the Diary page. Due to staffing and timetabling of PE we have needed to move Middleton assembly to the afternoon, we very much hope this doesn't cause any problems for anyone.

Pupil Voice:

In the next few weeks we will be appointing new Head Boy and Girls, prefects, house captains and of course School Council. We are looking at ways we can develop the roles further to give more children opportunities to have a say in what they want to achieve at school, what projects they want to develop and what changes they want to make. We will be sharing this with you as things develop and am sure you will support them in the challenges they set themselves.

This is going to be an exciting year for all our schools and our primary aim is to give our young children the best we can. We continue to fully embed the school 'motto' of 'Never Giving Less than our Best' and we will be expecting all the children to rise to this challenge.
