Dear Parents,

Welcome back, we hope you all had a lovely summer. This year Jupiter will have two teachers; Mrs Goddard on Monday and Tuesday and Mrs Taylor on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. P.E. will be on a Tuesday afternoon and for now, we are asking the children to come to school on that day dressed ready for PE.

Our over-arching theme for this half of the Autumn term is the historical covered by the reign of the Normans from 1066-1154. Most of our foundation subjects will be linked to this topic. For example, in music we will be composing battle music and in Design and technology we will be designing and construction a mechanism that may have been used in defence.

For Science this term we will be learning about sound; how it is made and how we hear sounds. We will be learning to understand a range of religious values and how these affect communities and their actions. We will be studying bible stories that relate to these moral values.
