

<b>Topic</b>	<b>British History – Who was Queen Victoria? Who was Florence Nightingale? Who is Queen Elizabeth? / All about me</b>
<b>Reading</b>	Discussing and responding to class texts- ‘Oi! Get Off Our Train’ by John Burningham and ‘The Queen’s Knickers’ by Nicholas Allan. Daily phonics.
<b>Writing</b>	Learn to write labels, lists and captions. Develop understanding of sentences and use this to write a letter.
<b>Maths</b>	White Rose Place Value will be the primary focus for this half of term. This will involve improving our understanding of numbers to 20 for Year 1 and to 100 for Year 2 children.
<b>Science</b>	Investigating living things- Food Chains Role play the interdependence between creatures in a chain. Finding own evidence of food chains in immediate environment. Asking questions. Identifying and classifying.
<b>History/Geography</b>	Investigate and Interpret the Past. Think about the evidence we have today and how it helps us understand things that have already taken place. See main topics.
<b>Art/D&amp;T</b>	Mastering Practical Skills. Start to show pattern, texture and tone using pencils and paint.
<b>Computing</b>	Communicate and Research Safely interact with others. Use websites for research.
<b>Relationships</b>	Think about our families and those who love us. Consider what makes a good friend.
<b>Music</b>	Composing and Performing. Understand that music is created to be performed.
<b>Religious Education</b>	Why do Christians pray to God?
<b>Primary Entitlement</b>	Present to the class.
